Respondent Characteristics

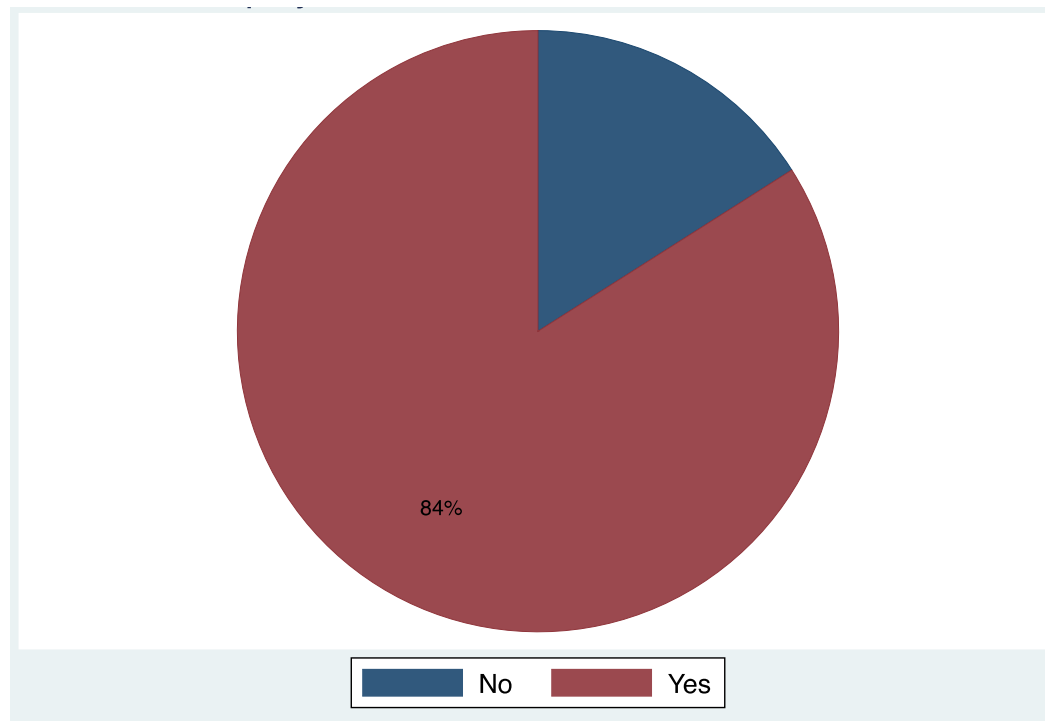
MSSP Graduates: May 2006 through May 2012

(64% response rate)

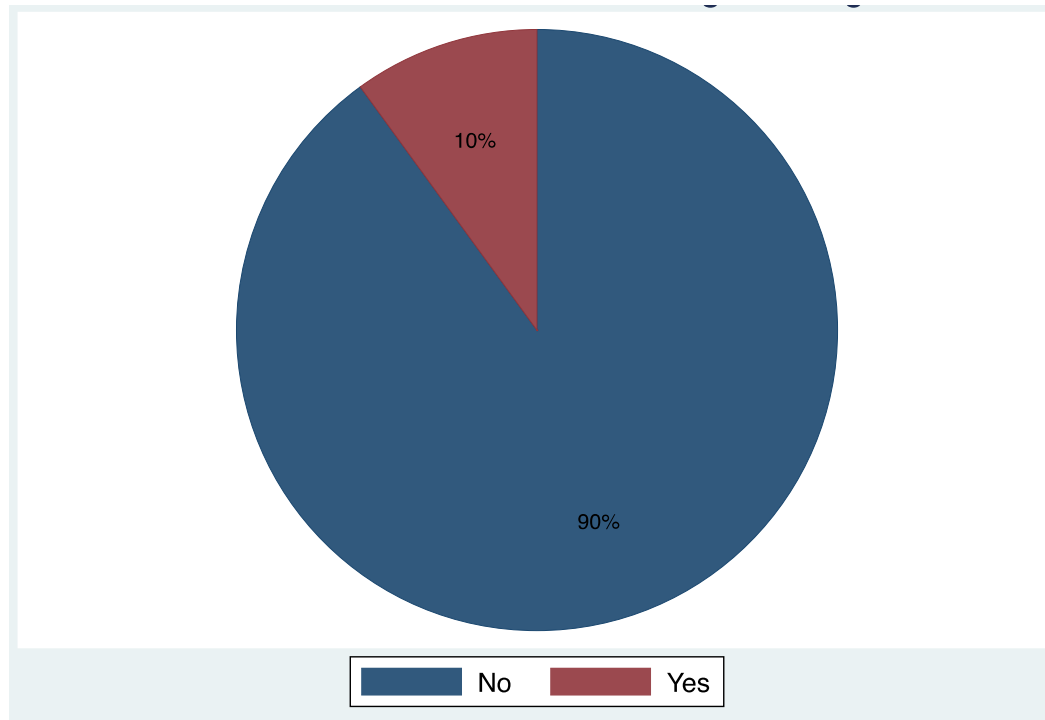
84% Employed by 6 Months after Graduation

If Employed Within 6 Months of Graduation

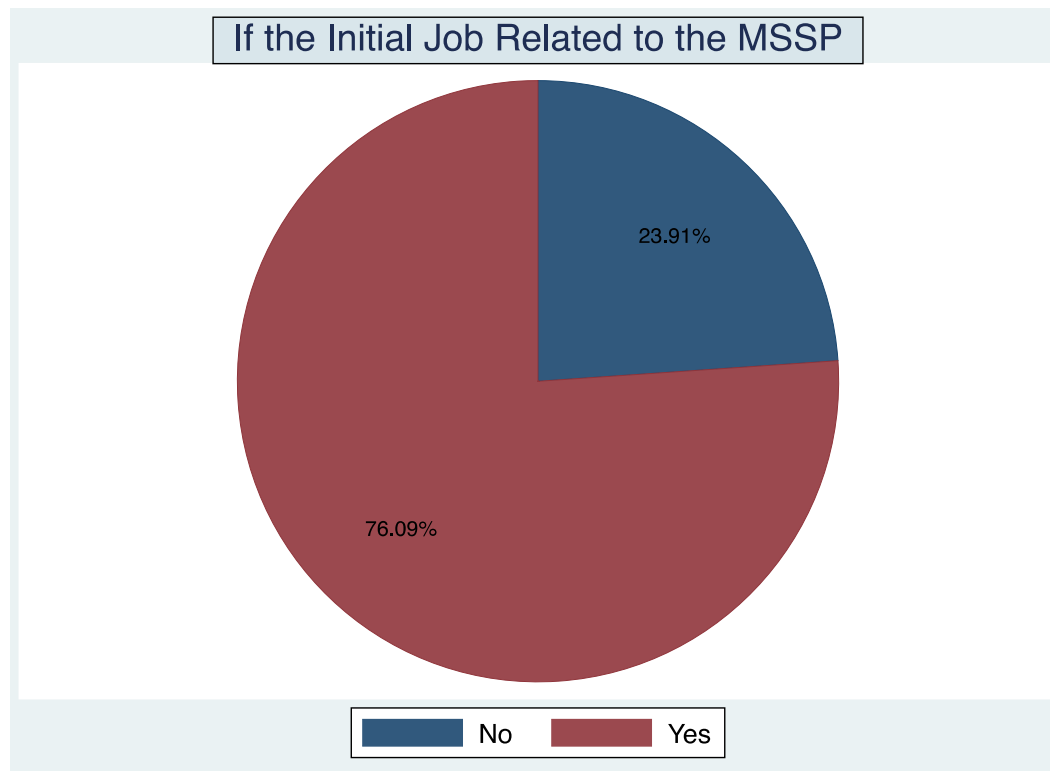


Of the 16% (n=6) not employed by 6 months after graduation, 5 of the 6 are in doctoral or law programs

Currently Enrolled in PhD or Law Degree Programs

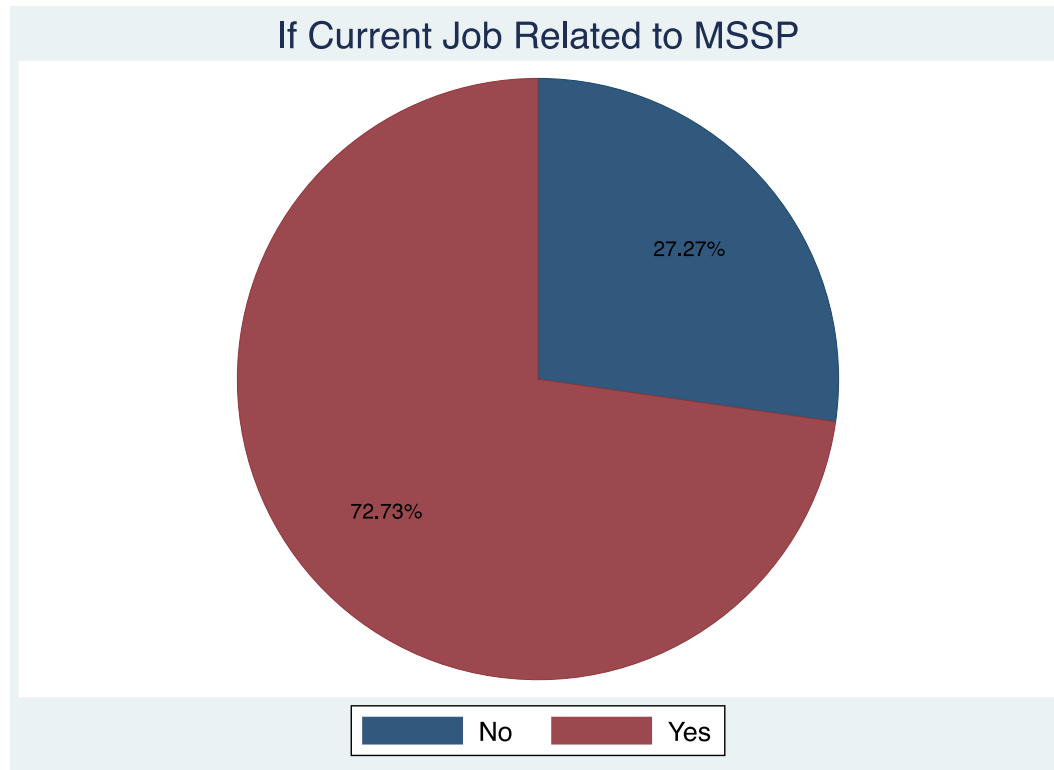


76% of First Jobs Were Related to the MSSP Program

8% (7%) Program or Research Coordinator

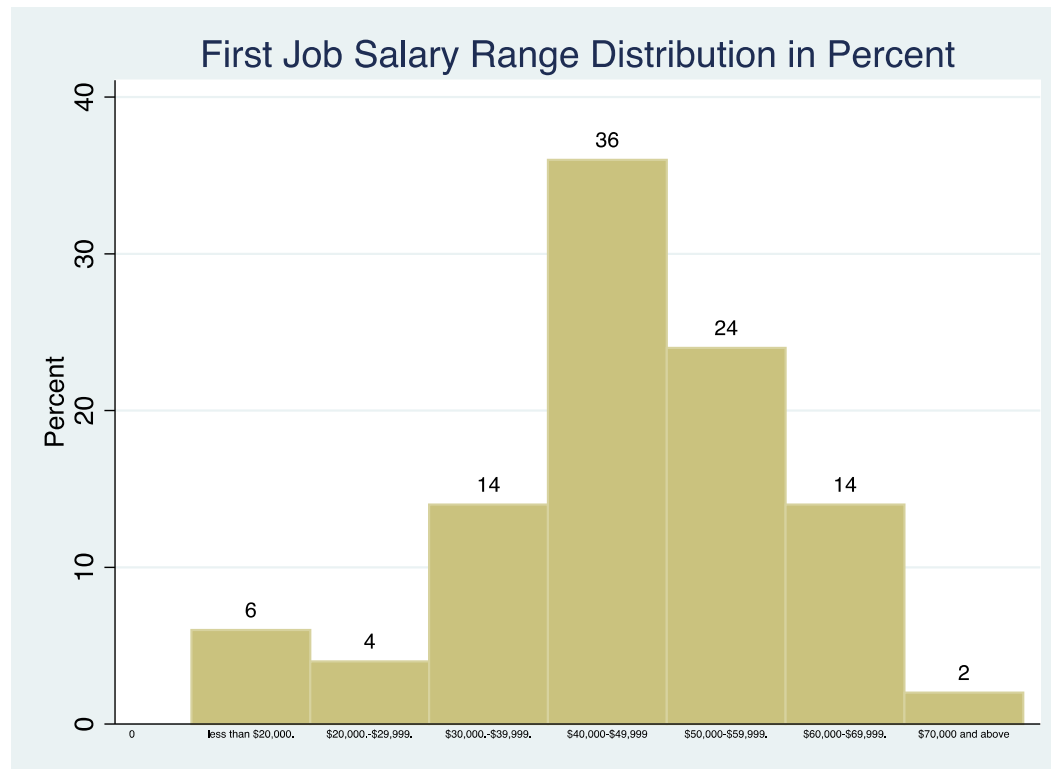
(These two are now 58% v 28%)

(Low end figures represent doctoral/law students)



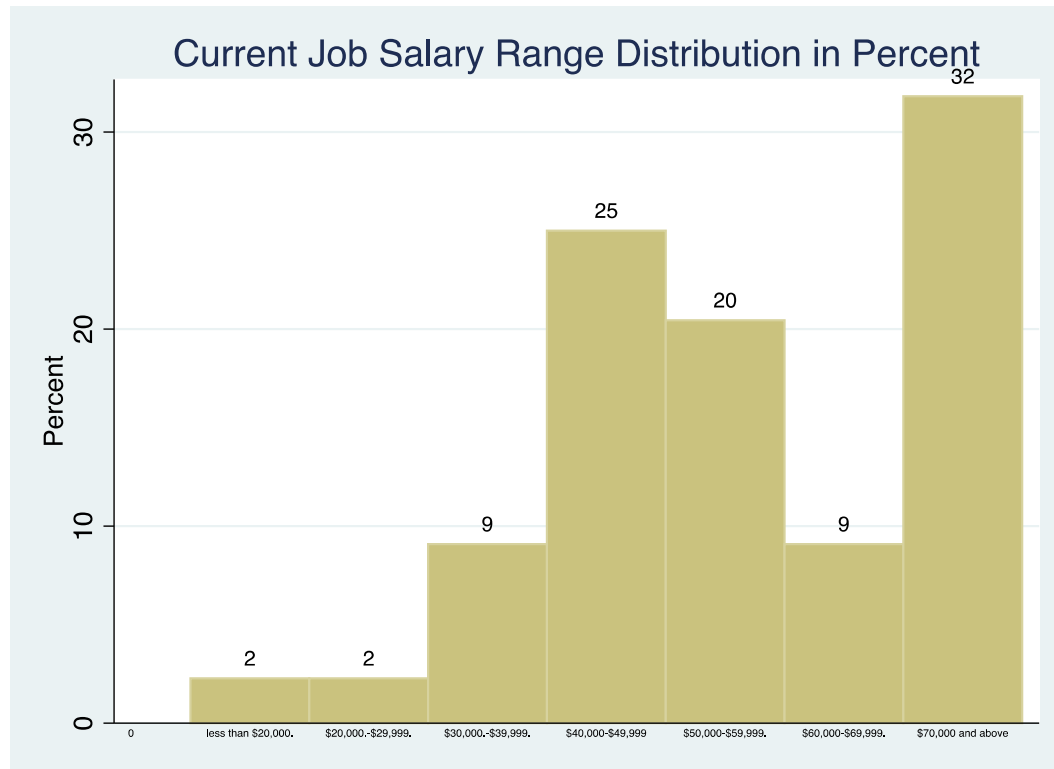
First Job Salary Range after MSSSP Graduation

Less than \$20,000	6%
\$20,000 - \$29,999	4%
\$30,000 - \$39,999	14%
\$40,000 – \$49,999	36%
\$50,000 – \$59,999	24%
\$60,000 - \$69,999	14%
\$70,000 and above	2%

On average, MSSSP graduates' first job salary was \$40,000 to \$49,999. 78% of MSSSP graduates earn \$40,000 or more in their first jobs. Lower figures tend to be part-time jobs or grad school stipends.

61% of MSSP graduates earn \$50,000 or more in their current jobs (conservative est; could be between 61% and 86%!)

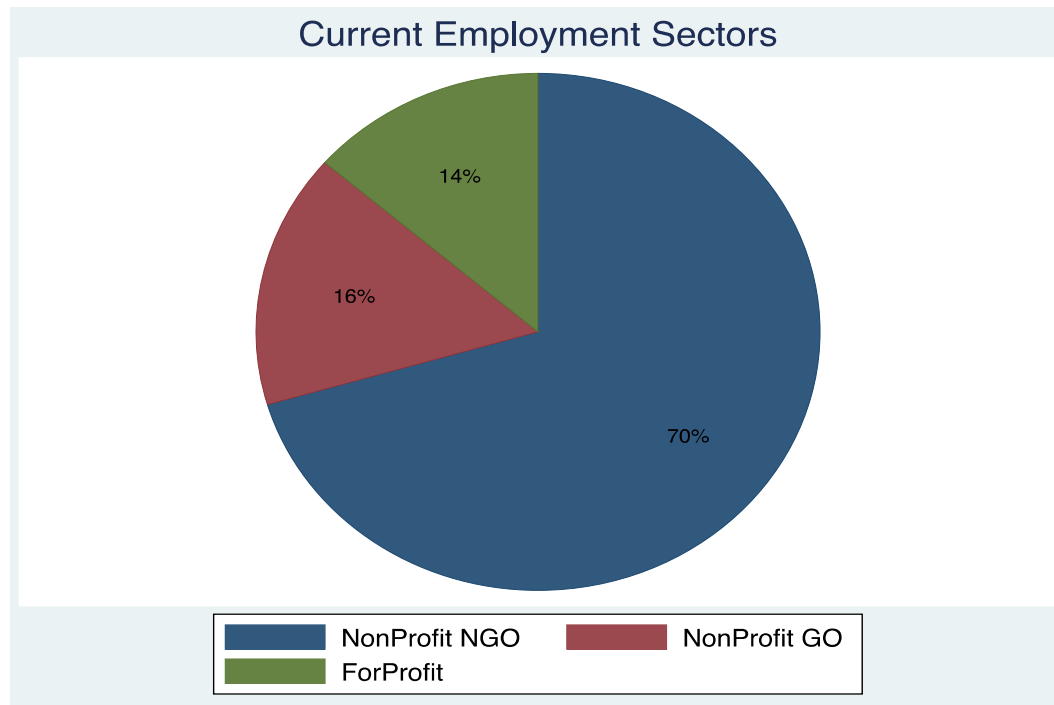

Location & Sector of Current Jobs

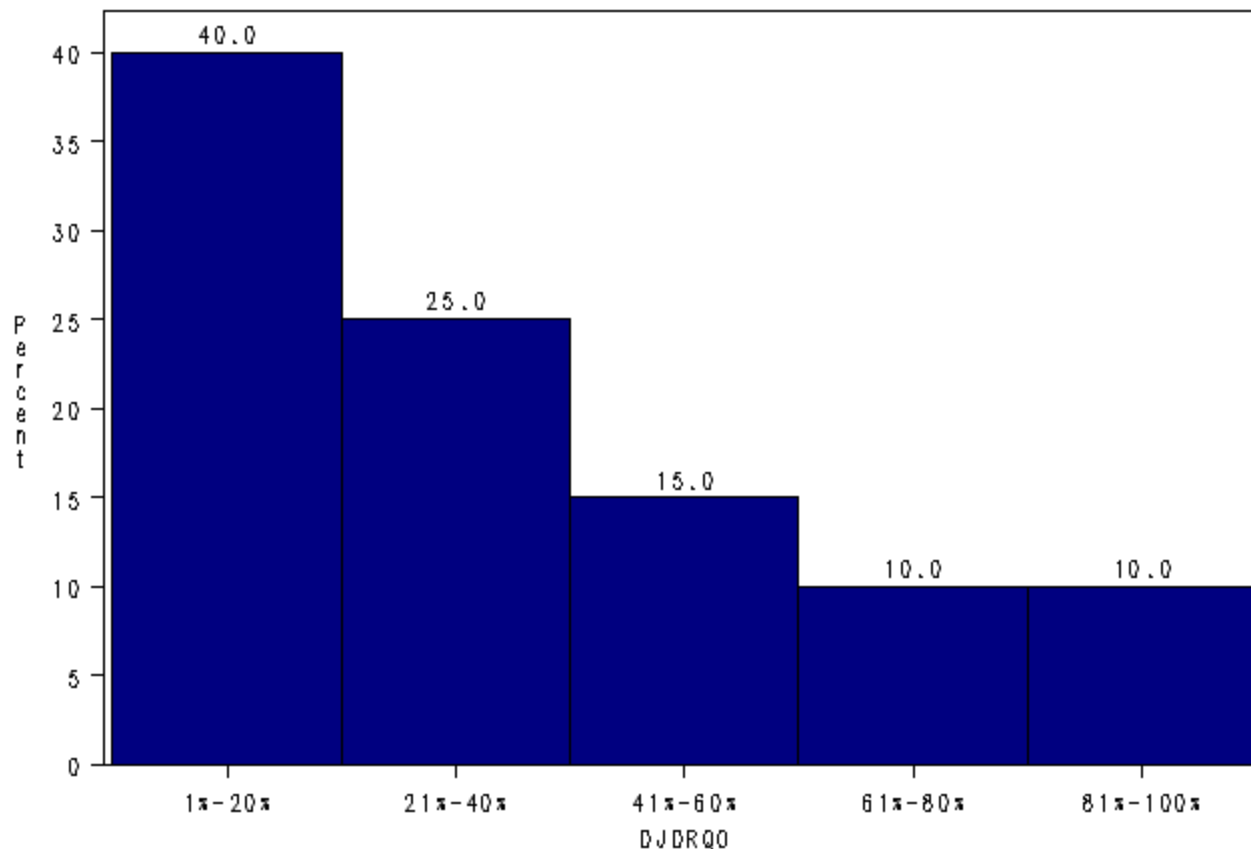
- 93% of current jobs are in the U.S.; 5% are in China; 2% in Canada

Median = 21% - 40%

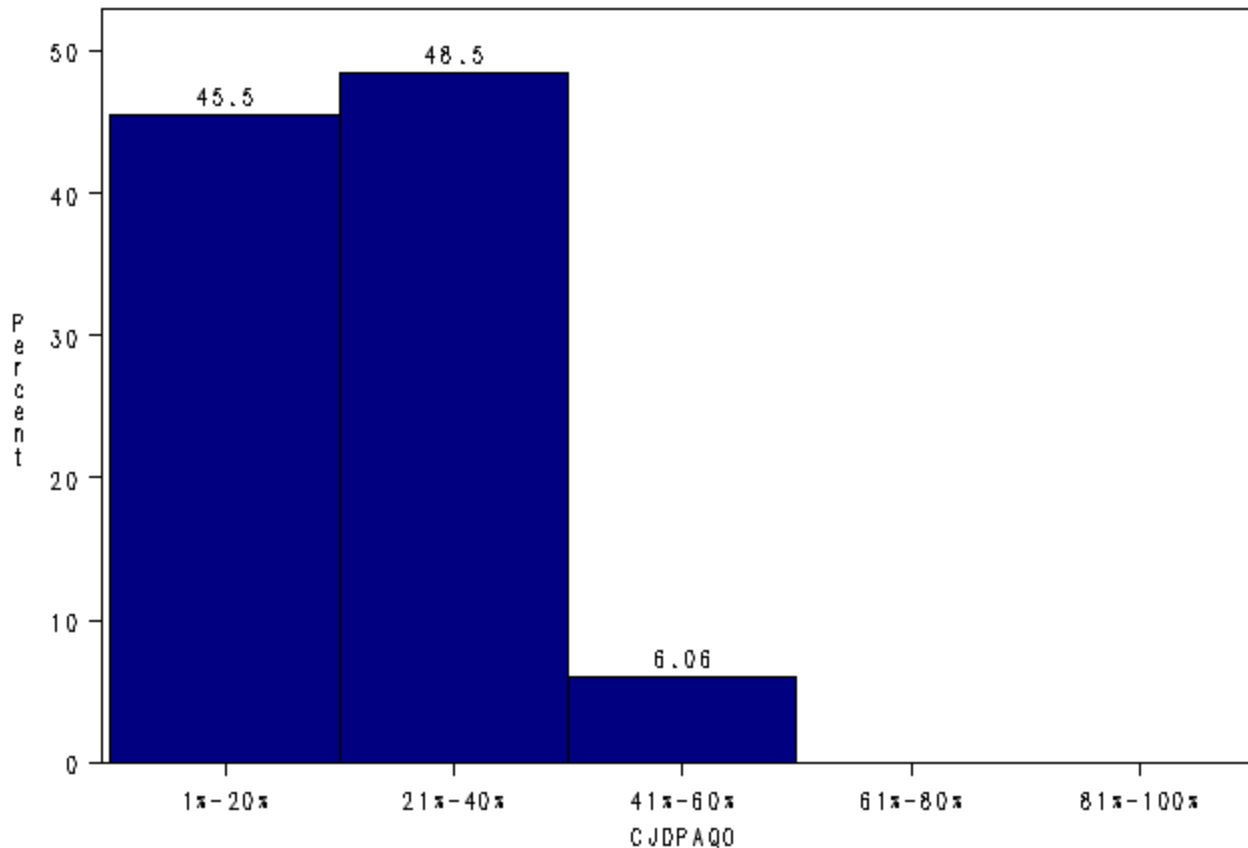
Current Job Description in Weight of Research

Median = 21% - 40%

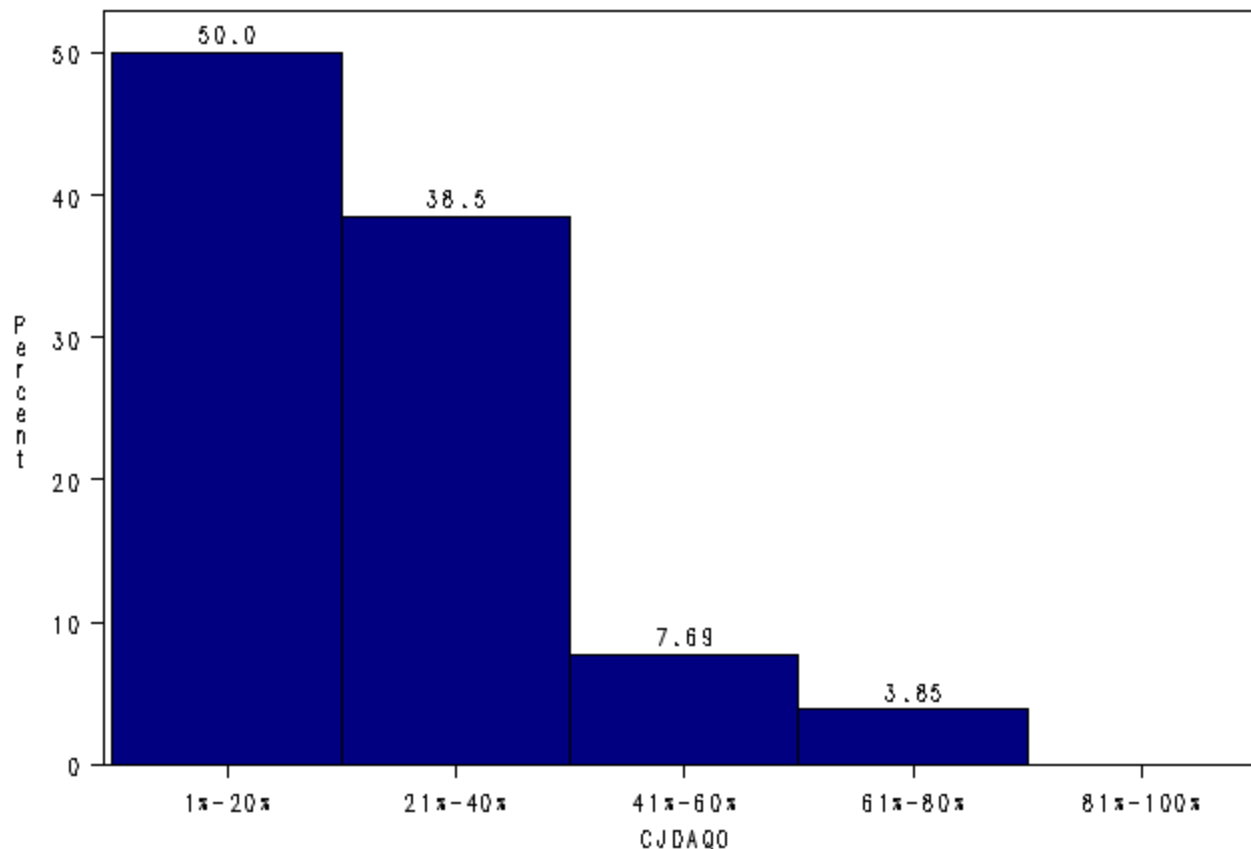
Current Job Description in Weight of Policy Analysis

Median = 21% - 40%

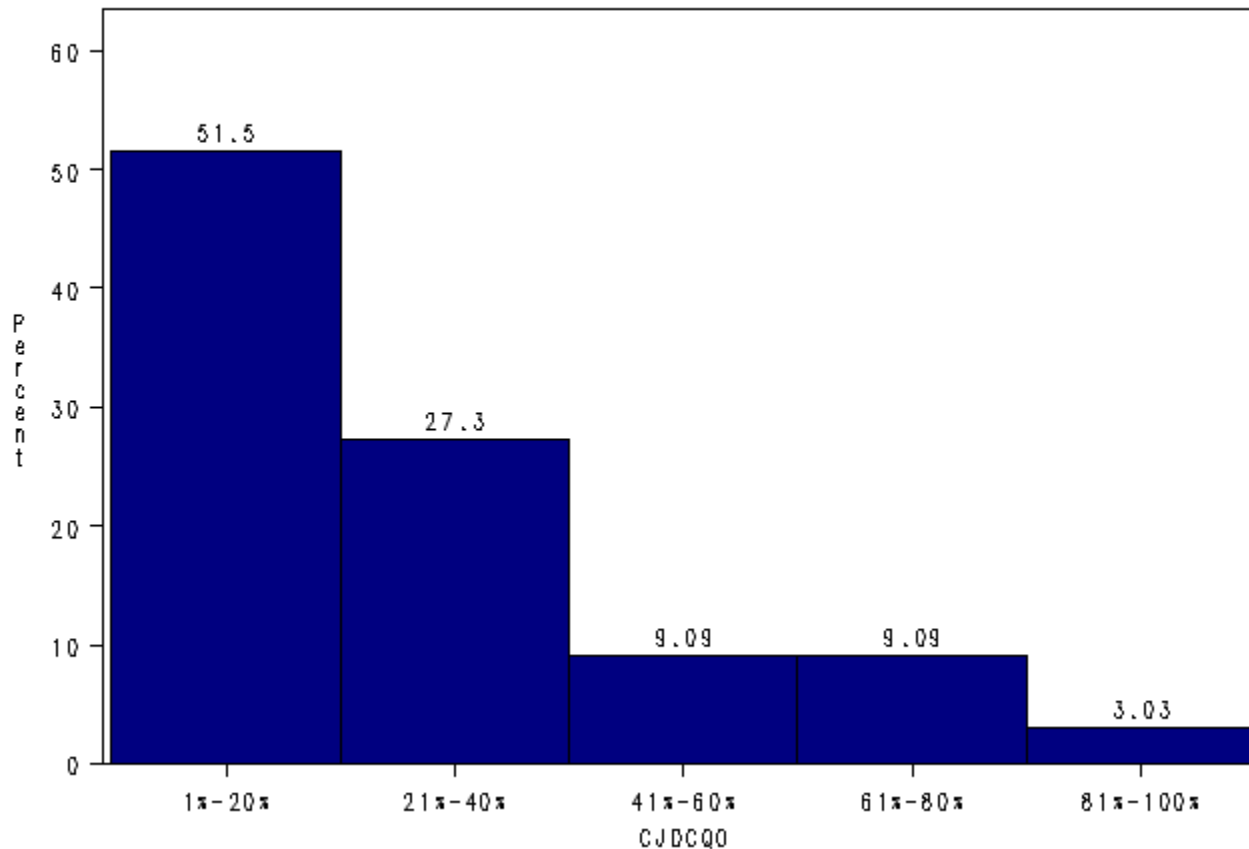
Current Job Description in Weight of Advocacy

Median = 1%- 20%

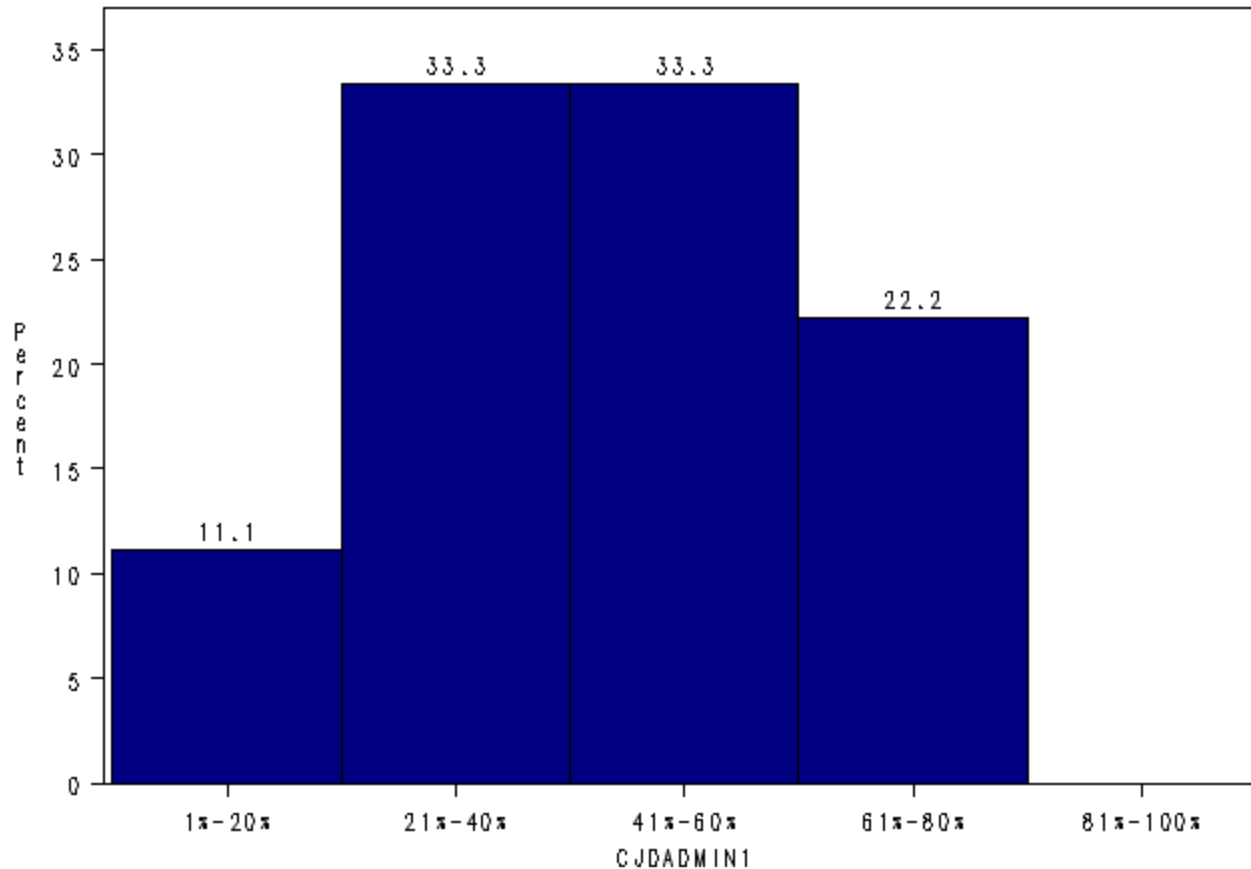
Current Job Description in Weight of Communication
